4. Course Analysis

The Airline Pilot Preparation consists of the following sections:

- **GROUND PREPARATION PILOT TEST:**

▶ MATHS/PHYSICS

02 hours advanced test

▶ APTITUDE & COMPASS TEST

08 hours (2 sessions) of psychotechnical and psychometric tests on the following categories:

- MEMORY
- ATTENTION
- SPATIAL
- DEXERITY

-NUMERICAL
-REASONING
-ORIENTATION

- **HR PILOT PREPARATION:**

03 hours preparation on specific questions based on the questions that the airlines include in their interviews.

- **SIMULATOR SESSION/PREPARATION:**

05 hours technical training on SIM (FNPT II) or on the appropriated computer system (if needed)

- **INTERNAL EXAMS:**

▶ 1st day: all written Exams (5 hours)

▶ 2nd day: Simulator Assessment (2 hours)

▶ 3rd day: Debriefing (1 hour)
